The RISEUP program pairs qualified students with professional mentors from nonprofits, academia, and the private sector to investigate multiple-stakeholder environmental issues of Southeast Michigan and the Lake Erie to Lake Huron Corridor.

The program features a series of biweekly workshops aimed to build communication and leadership skills. The program's integrated mentorship combines laboratory and field environments to provide a dynamic research experience.

Interns are provided with a research stipend of \$4000, their findings will be featured in an online publication, and they will have the opportunity to present their work at a university research symposium.
